March 22, 2010

Meeting called to order by president, Nancy Determan

Roll Call was taken and new members introduced.

Secretary and Treasurer's reports were read and approved.

Correspondence:

- Cindy reviewed fliers for upcoming trail rides.
- Waterama parade is July 25, we will send in registration and narration.
- Glenwood fire department's Fish Fry is March 26th. A motion was made and seconded to send them a donation of \$10 since they helped us with our arena during our open show last year.
- Cindy had received a WSCA rulebook for the club. Anyone wanting their own copy should order from WSCA or pick up a book at the Horse Expo.

Show Committee:

The dates for the fun shows were discussed and left the same as before with the June show starting at 9:00am since it's a club member's wedding that day. The August show falls on the same date as the Douglas County Fair and a few of our members have to leave their horses at the fairgrounds or forfeit their premiums. After much discussion a motion was made and seconded to leave it as the 22nd since there seems to be no open days that month.

Kay is in charge of sending out sponsorship letters for the open show.

Trail Committee:

Janice Johnson and Peggy Haavig volunteered to head this committee this year and welcome ideas for trail rides in the area.

Parade Committee:

Jim Kraft brought up that it seems like there are not many blue saddle pads left. It was pointed out that they may have been left in the crow's nest. Jim will take an inventory. A motion was made and seconded to not use leg wraps on the horses for parades in the future.

Old Business:

The fundraiser for Kay has gone well. We have a few shirts left to sell. A motion was made and seconded to give Kay \$500 of the profits now and see if we can sell more shirts in the future.

New Business:

We discussed getting more blue logo shirts. Chris brought up that we had ordered last year and there were some that were never paid for or picked up. She would like it if we had a more organized procedure for ordering shirts so she has made up an order form. She has a list of numbers that are available if anyone would like their number on the back of the shirt. It was noted that we wear white polo shirts for parades but they do not have to have our logo on them, though they are available.

Patsy Ascheman's mother died recently. A motion was made and seconded to send her family a card and \$25.

Nancy Determan had attended the last fair board meeting. They would like ideas about what to do to improve the fair grounds. It was suggested that we ask to have more trees planted in the horse barn area. Nancy will bring this up to the Board.
